The look on my clients faces when they say: "Thank you!", "You inspired me!", Healing broken hearts and giving a word of hope to the broken. What makes me excited is when others are willing & excited to apply the thoughts that become actions!

Ms. Lewis shares her story of once being very driven, motivated, seeking answers and support when she could not find any from her close ones including her husband. Ms. Lewis often shares that after being disappointed by family, a husband and parents; she now holds the motivation to give to others what is often missing from their close ones –

ENCOURAGEMENT, HOW TO, I CAN DO IT TOO! She is often grateful for other resources, experienced individuals and life experiences that have given her a second chance; and the answers that she so needed to press on to her other goals.

She completed a Bachelor's Degree at the age of 23, got married, and lived a life for ten years being empty and still. She explains that she did not know who she was and what was her purpose because she stood still and looked in the wrong places for answers. After listening to motivated individuals, reading books, joining groups and engaging in seminars, Ms. Lewis today has pressed on and achieved an MBA, minor in Human Resources, founder of NPO-HEI, Holistic Education Institute, and Educator. She is currently considering a PhD in Public Policy and Administration to effectively and efficiently advocate for change that positively impacts individuals and communities.
